3. **Paper length:** Abstract limited to 500-1000 words/Full paper limited to 5000 words minus title page
4. **Document Format:** MSWord
5. **Copyright:** Paper presenters are responsible to obtain all necessary copyright for the submission.
6. **Submissions:** All submissions should be by email.
